HOG TROUGH

The following recipe may be found in the Tasting New Mexico Cookbook, by Cheryl Alters Jamison and Bill Jamison, and a version of it may be ordered at the Gorge Bar & Grill in Taos, New Mexico. Serve with charred tortillas, if desired!

Sirloin Green Chile Stew

- 1 T Vegetable Oil
- 1 t Salt, or to taste
- 1/2 t Black Pepper, or to taste
- 2 lbs. Beef Sirloin, cut into ¾ inch cubes
- 2 Q Water or Vegetable Stock
- 1 C Diced Carrots
- 1 C Diced Onions
- 1 C Peeled and Diced Red Potatoes
- 6 Garlic Cloves, Minced
- 4 C Roasted, Peeled, Seeded and Chopped Green Chiles
- 2 T Bacon Fat, or more to taste

Heat the vegetable oil in a large saucepan over high heat. Add the beef with salt and pepper. Brown the beef on all sides. Add the water, or vegetable stock, and scrape all the brown bits from the bottom of the pan. Add the carrots, onions, potatoes, garlic, green chile and bacon fat.

Reduce heat and simmer until the beef and vegetables are tender, about 30 minutes.

Ladle the stew into bowls. May be served with shredded Monterey Jack cheese and

Last September my wife treated me to a vacation in the Hawaiian Islands, as a retirement present. One reason we went to Hawaii is because that was the last state I needed to ride a bike in to have ridden in all 50 states!! We rented an Ultra-classic from Big Island Harley-Davidson, in Kailua Kona. The employees were very friendly and accommodating. We received a HOG discount on the rental and got some great advice on where to ride and what to see on our ride.

I started riding Harleys to clear my head, after my father passed away in 1997. My first trip was on a 1993, 883 Sportster Hugger. I picked up my first 16 states on that trip. In 2012 I went to Alaska and rode around there for 18 days. That is a whole different story. 2013 I went to my grandson's HS graduation. He now has the '93 Sportster. Afterwards I went out of the way to go through Tennessee and Arkansas, the last two I needed, in the lower 48. And that brings us around to Hawaii, number 50!
